## SELF-ASSESSMENT

- REVIEW THE CONTENT OUTLINE**

Make sure you are familiar with all the topics on the certification exam. Finding domains where the tasks seem unfamiliar may indicate an area you need to study.
- REVIEW THE SAMPLE QUESTIONS**

NBPHE provides ten sample questions to give you a general sense of how CPH questions are written so you know what to expect.
- TAKE A PRACTICE EXAM**

NBPHE offers two free CPH practice exams, which are the most accurate representations of the CPH exam. How you perform on a practice exam should guide you in deciding where to study. Take the practice exams at least once or more to see how you are improving.
- CREATE A STUDY PLAN**

Once you understand which domain areas are your strongest and which you may need to focus on more, create a study plan. NBPHE offers study tips for preparing for a certification test and a Personal Action Plan worksheet to guide your study plan.

- PURCHASE CPH STUDY MATERIALS**

Study materials are excellent resources for an overview of what to expect on a certification exam. There are three different study guides available for the CPH.

Access NBPHE's archived webinars that review each domain area on the CPH exam to help review the content of each domain.
